Institutional Capacity Building

Integrate trade and strengthen institutional capacities with the purpose of the country leading their own trade and development agenda

Diagnostic Trade Integration Study (DTIS)

Identify the country's biggest constraints to trade integration, prioritize actions to address them and harmonize efforts to provide trade-related support Productive Capacity Building

Address priorities through concrete and specific projects in coordination with governments, donors and the EIF Trust Fund
